GENERAL BUSINESS:

POST OFFICE BOX

RF – Proposed that a post office box at the Hermit Park Post Office be purchased for convienance. The estimated cost is \$90 per year.

The proposal was voted on and supported by majority.

CLUB WEBSITE

RF – reminded members that the club's website contains profiles of club members and their vehicles. Members who are not listed are requested to provide their details.

SAUSAGE SIZZLE

JF – Members are reminded that the next sausage sizzle is scheduled for Sunday 14th March. CS – enquired if the club has to comply with Food Handlers Requirements/Regulations *In response to the enquiry the following summary is provided for the benefit of members.* Non-profit organisations are allowed a number of exemptions under the Food Act 2006. These exemptions are provided so that non-profit organisations can sell food as fundraising activities but ensuring that the handling of food is done in a safe and suitable manner.

Licensing - A non-profit organisation is <u>not</u> required to hold a Temporary Food Stall Licence if it sells "meals" on less than 12 days per financial year. A "meal" is defined as food that is intended to be consumed sitting down with cutlery at a table or other fixed structure.

Accredited Food Handlers - A non-profit organisation does <u>not</u> require to have accredited and/or trained food handlers at a fundraising event where the food is consumed immediately after thorough cooking or the handling of non-potentially hazardous foods is involved.

However non-profit organisations are obligated to comply with the Food Act 2006 and handle only safe and suitable food. This includes compliance with the Food Safety Standards.

It is intended that a Food Handling Manual will be prepared and be available to the members at the next sausage sizzle to be held on 14th March. The manual will contain information on issues such as:-

- General requirements of Food Handling
- Responsibilities of Food Handlers
- Temperature Control and Potentially Hazardous Foods
- The 4 Hour/2 Hour Guide
- Guidelines for the Minimum Standard of Operation of Temporary Food Stalls

All members are encouraged to become familiar with the food handling requirements and their own responsibilities to ensure that the club conducts the sausage sizzles in a professional and safe manner.
