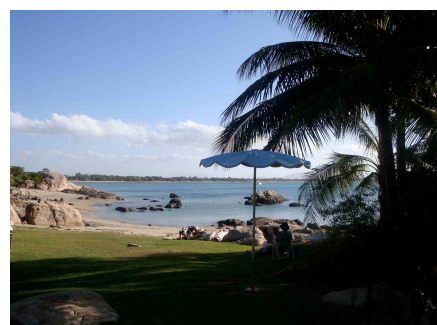


Later we travelled to Lucinda for an overnight stop.
