*A great weekend was held on the tablelands. The historical museum at Herberton was again very interesting with the group awarded a special personal preview of motor vehicles that are not on public display.*

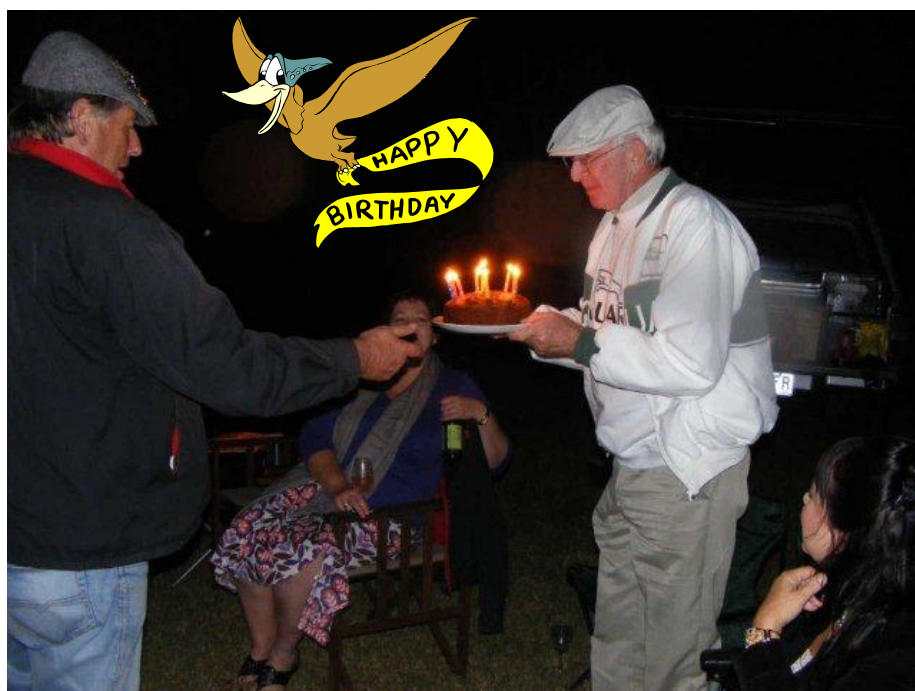
