



"DID YOU KNOW"

Some Interesting Reading Insert from Peter Dixon

*Did you know t*hat the mercury switch for XJ bootlights are identical to those fitted to the Rover 90, 95, 2000 and 3500V8, plus the Humber Super Snipe.

*Did you know t*hat the plastic water-bottle fitted to the later S-Type, E-Type, Mkil and 420G is the same as fitted to the Triumph 2500TC, S, P1 and Stag.

Did you know the glass water bottle fitted to the Mark VII, XK140 is the same as fitted to early Humber Super Snipes.

*Did you know t*hat the vacuum tank for the brakes on the S-Type, MKII, E-Type 420G etc., is the same as used on the 100E Prefect for the windscreen washer vacuum tank.

Did you know that the reversing light on the XK140 is the same as that used on the Wolseley 4/44, Vanguard Spacemaster and the Rover 90 and 95.

Did you know metalastic rubber exhaust mounting brackets on most models up to 420G are identical with those used in early Austin, Morris and Wolseley.

*Did you know t*hat an SS or MKIV can be rebored .30in, and standard MKII pistons fitted. One good suggestion at this stage is to fit steel con-rods. Also, the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ litre engine can be bored to take FX Holden pistons.

*Did you know t*hat the front wheel bearings used on all models from MKII to XJ are the same as used by Holden.

*Did you know t*hat the Commodore power steering pump has an identical seal kit to the XJ, regrettably that is where the similarity ends.
