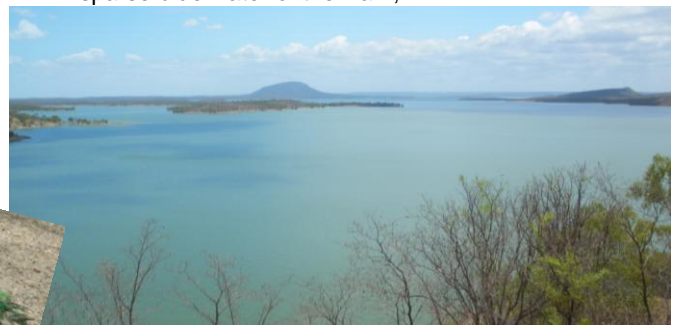
Ravenswood/Burdekin Dam Trip 22nd/23rd Oct 2011

We were joined by many of the wild birds, a peacock became very friendly eating out of our hands, enjoying every morsel.



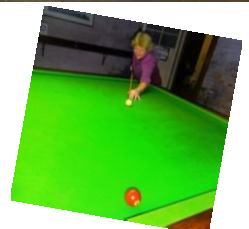
