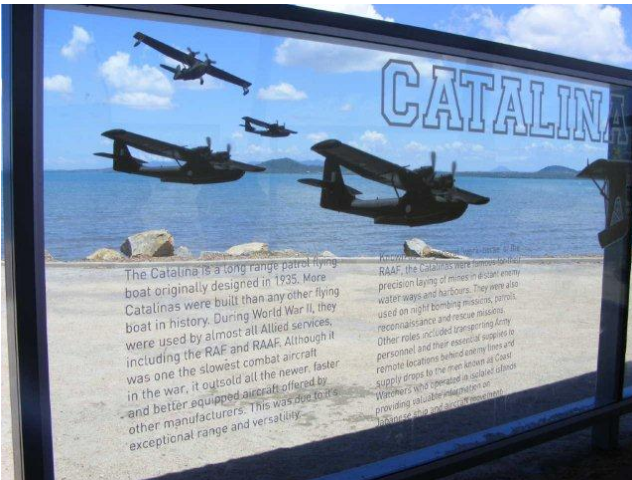
Walked to the Cove Restaurant on Saturday night for dinner, where Peter kept us in stitches with his jokes.
